What is it?

Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council, on behalf of the five Tees Valley councils, has been awarded funding from the Warm Homes Fund to install FREE central heating systems, subject to eligibility and survey, into properties across the area.

The project is supported by your local Citizens Advice Bureau, and Middlesbrough Environment City. These partner organisations will be able to provide additional services such as a free and confidential appointment with a CAB Adviser to:

- help you check you are on the best fuel tariff
- give you free and confidential advice on energy costs
- help you improve energy efficiency in the home and save money

How do I qualify?

1) You are a homeowner, or have a private landlord if you rent

- 2) i) Your home does not have, and never has had a central heating system.
 - *If you have storage heaters, electric room heaters, solid fuel fires and single gas fires you may qualify as they do not count as central heating systems.
 - ii) The main method of heating your home is by the use of solid fuels.
